



StressDat database

EULA – End User License Agreement version 1.0 – 11/11/2022

1. This user agreement applies to the StressDat database which was recorded by Institute of Informatics of the Slovak Academy of Sciences. The signee of this document must hold a permanent position at an academic institute. Up to five other researchers affiliated with the same institute for whom the signee is responsible may be named at the end of this document, which will allow them to work with the StressDat database.

2. Commercial use

The user may not use the database for any commercial purposes. Commercial purposes include, but are not limited to:

- proving the efficiency of commercial systems,
- testing commercial systems,
- selling data from the database.

To use the database for commercial purposes user is supposed to contact Institute of Informatics, Slovak Academy of Sciences by mail.

3. Distribution

The user may not distribute the database in any way. Small portions (audio sample) may be distributed in publications as long as the publication complies with the terms stated in this EULA (article 4).

4. Publications

Publications include not only papers, but also presentations for conferences or educational purposes.

The user may use screenshots, audio sample of subjects in publications.

All documents and papers that report on research that uses the StressDat database will acknowledge this by citing the following paper:

The user may only use the database after this EULA has been signed and returned to the StressDat database holder, Institute of Informatics of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (II SAS). The user must return the signed EULA by email, in PDF or JPEG format to

The RECOLA database holder reserves the right to change this EULA at any time; users will be informed about changes beforehand and given the choice to opt out of the new EULA. Opting out will not render the previous EULA void.

7. Warranty

The database comes without any warranty, the II SAS cannot be held accountable for any damage (physical, financial or otherwise) caused by the use of the StressDat database. No

legal claims of any kind can be derived from accepting and using the dataset.

8. Destruction

Once the user won't need to use anymore the RECOLA database, he or she will have to erase and destruct all copies (including backups and archives) of this corpus, as well as those that might have been given to affiliated researchers (article 1).
